You don't have to know how to pop, we'll be glad to teach you.

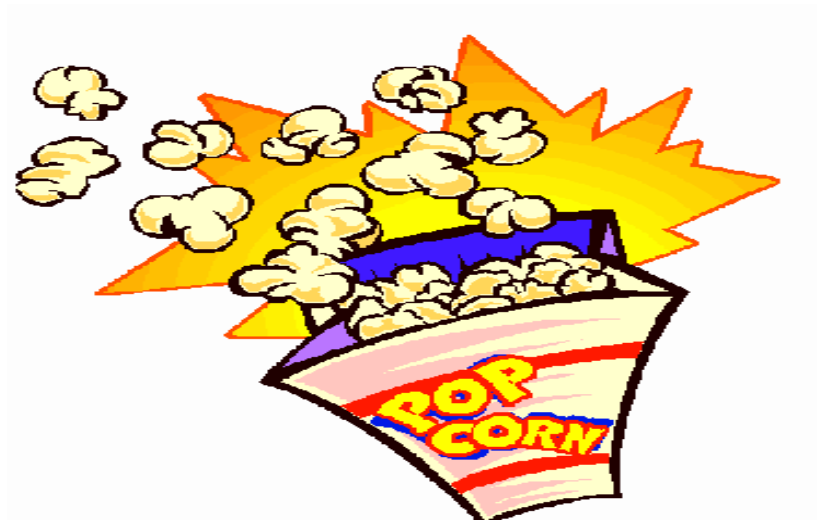


IT'S EASY!!

September is National Head Lice Prevention Month

The Portsmouth School Nurses are coordinating a Team approach in the prevention and treatment of pediculosis. We are asking you to work with us to prevent the spread of this communicable problem. Working together will enable us to provide a quicker and easier resolution to this problem and prevent absences from school. Our approach is based on the current NHDHHS Guidelines and the American Academy of Pediatrics and Harvard School of Public Health Guidelines.

September is National Head Lice Prevention Month. We encourage all parents to check their child's head weekly as a prevention effort. Usually, the first sign of a case of head lice is the symptom or observation of your child itching and scratching the head. Please read the attached Head Lice Parent Handout.

Some facts about lice:

- Lice are easily transmitted from one child to another via DIRECT head-to head contact, or via the sharing of combs and brushes, hats, headphones, etc.
- Lice can only crawl. These parasites CAN NOT hop, jump, or fly,
- Lice are not associated with uncleanness or poor personal hygiene.
- Lice are small, brown, the size of sesame seed.
- Nits are small, gray/white and oval shaped. Nits are firmly attached to the hair shaft, generally close to the scalp.

Please follow these simple steps:

- Carefully examine the hair and scalp (especially behind the ear and the nape of the neck) of your children and all family members for lice and their eggs (nits) periodically through the school year.
- If your child scratching his or here head often, check for lice.
 - Instruct your children not to use or borrow anyone's comb, brush, hair accessories, hats, headphones or other similar items.
 - Communication is an essential part of this cooperative Team effort. If you find that your child has head lice, please inform the following people: Your child's School Nurse and the parent's of your child's playmates.

We appreciate all of your efforts in eliminating this frustrating problem. If your child does have head lice, or if you have any questions or concerns, please call your Primary Provider or contact your School's Nurse for specific treatment recommendations.

Together, with education, we may all understand, care and prevent this common problem in school-aged children. Thank you.
