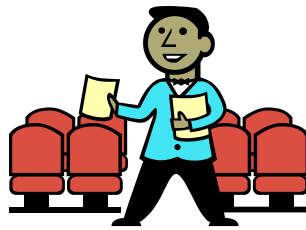

Dear Dondero School Parents/Guardians:

As you may be aware, there has been a movement in the Portsmouth School District to provide Interactive White Board Technology to our students over the last few years. In 2008, Dondero was provided two "Smart Boards" through a grant. They currently are installed in one 4th and one 5th grade classroom.

During an educational session prior to the November 5th PTA meeting, Dondero fifth grade teacher, Josh Evans demonstrated the power of this technology using lesson examples for Math, Social Studies, and Writing. This technology allows for immediate access to the Internet, past units of study as reference tools, as well as quick student or class assessments using Activote clickers. This technology allows both the teacher AND the student a new and interactive way to participate in academic learning.

During this presentation, a motion was made requesting that the PTA match up to \$2500 of any funds raised to purchase this technology. The motion passed during the meeting.
