# June Minutes

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## Principal's Report: Kate

- Dondero is a Blue Ribbon School!
- This year presents a high kindergarten population, assistants have been hired for those classrooms
- The first 6 weeks of school are a gradual transition to learning with emphasis on social emotional and basic skills and expectations for being part of a school community
- Third grade reading assessments underway to inform instruction
- September assessments will determine math and reading placements
- Fourth and Fifth grades have already hade their first field trips
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade beginning the "Summit to Sea" program

# Treasurer's Report: Molly

- Goal for 2023-2024 To cover the cost of all busing for field trips and cost of trip
- All teachers received a \$50 Amazon gift card for their classrooms. Amber will be posting some of the purchases on social media
- \$150 was spent on Fairy House Club, will need to be added to the budget for next pear
- PTA to pay for back to school luncheon for teachers
- We received a check for \$1,745 from TreeRing
- The Playground savings account has been closed and rolled into the general PTA checking account. The balance of \$12,978.53 that was combined will be earmarked for the Playground.
- Current bank balance is \$34,669.99 (including playground money)
